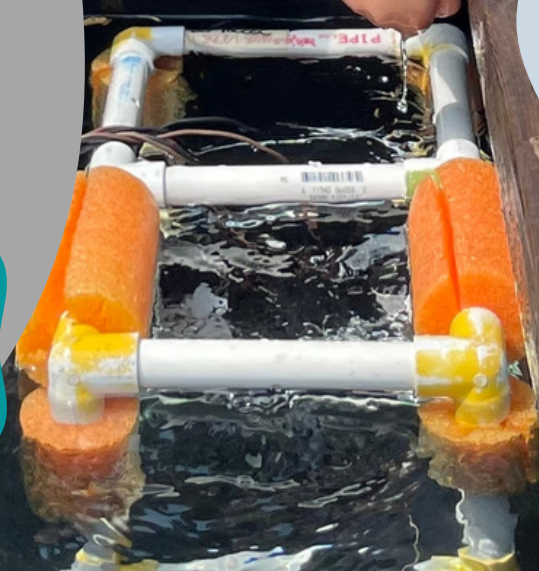

BEESMART 2021

5 weeks of hands-on summer learning for 61 students
(2nd through rising 5th grade)
at two partner schools in South Baltimore



Academic Gains



- 100% of participating youth triumphed over summer learning loss. 78% increased their reading level and 22% maintained their reading level.
- 94% of participants increased their math fact fluency with an average increased proficiency of 11 facts per minute.

Parent/Caregiver Approval

100% of parents/caregivers indicated that . . .

- . . . their child really liked BEESMART.
- . . . the BEESMART rules were fair.
- . . . BEESMART teachers expected their child to do her/his best.



Family Involvement



Through in-person special events, participation in their child's virtual mentoring sessions, and completion of Parent Input forms

100% of families were actively involved in their child's summer learning.

Social-Emotional Gains

BEESMART students worked with caring adults to set goals and achieve milestones.

- 92% of students successfully set personal and academic goals.
- 88% of those students were able to achieve at least one milestone toward their goal during the summer program.
- 83% of students demonstrated an understanding of and appreciation for high expectations.
